## Board Meeting Notes 8/24/2023

In the conversation, Pranav, Linda, Jessica, Dennis, and Larkin discussed updates on staff hiring, budget requests, and potential changes to the office lease. They also mentioned upcoming trips, recent travels, and the status of tax filings.

- Jessica, Brittany, Linda, and Larkin discussed fundraising updates and grant applications. They confirmed that the organization has a good amount of money in the bank to feel secure through 2023, and were waiting to hear back about new grants, while also considering the possibility of getting a new space with a month of rent overlap.

- Linda discussed the importance of resolving DBA issues and exploring additional income streams, such as marketing DBA.

They considered previous practices and suggested placing training programs under office supplies and adding conference expenses to the travel category.

They agreed to proceed with the proposed budget, with the understanding that projected revenue still needed to be secured to avoid cuts in other areas.

They considered taking up Linda's offer to write the handbook and employee policies, with Larkin suggesting that the lawyer review certain sensitive policies within it.

- Larkin, Pranav, Jessica, Dana, and Brittany discussed rotating meeting facilitators. They also mentioned upcoming events and expressed excitement about meeting in person.
